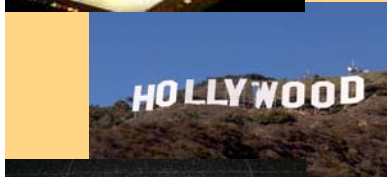

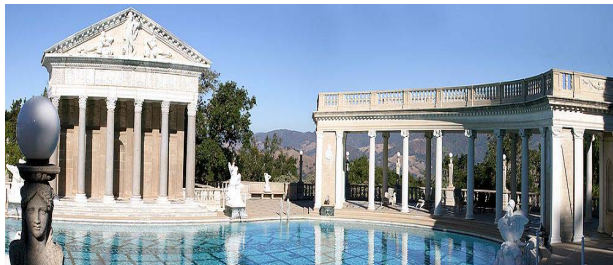

**Ronald Reagan Presidential Library** - Artifacts from President Reagan's childhood and professional career provide physical evidence of his extraordinary life. **Hearst Castle** - **Hearst Castle** was the palatial estate of newspaper magnate William Randolph Hearst. It is located near San Simeon, California, on a hill overlooking the Pacific Ocean.

**SAN FRANCISCO** - (2 Nights Downtown) City tour with step-on guide. San Francisco is renowned for its steep rolling hills, an eclectic mix of Victorian and modern architecture, and famous landmarks, including the **Golden Gate Bridge**, **Alcatraz Island**, the **cable cars**, **Coit Tower**, and **Chinatown**.

**Golden Gate Bridge** - The **Golden Gate Bridge** has become an internationally recognized symbol of San Francisco and the United States. It has the second longest suspension bridge main span in the US.

**Alcatraz Island** - Alcatraz Island offers a close-up look at the site of the first lighthouse and US fort on the West Coast, and the infamous federal penitentiary long off-limits to the public.

#### UTAH

**SALT LAKE CITY** - (1 Night) is the capital and the most populous city of Utah. We will stay across the street from Temple Square.

**Temple Square** - This beautifully landscaped 10-acre plot of ground in the heart of downtown Salt Lake City is one of Utah's most visited attractions. It's centerpiece is the 6-spired granite Salt Lake Temple, and adjacent to this imposing edifice is the domed Tabernacle, home of the famous Mormon Tabernacle Choir and the great Tabernacle Organ.
