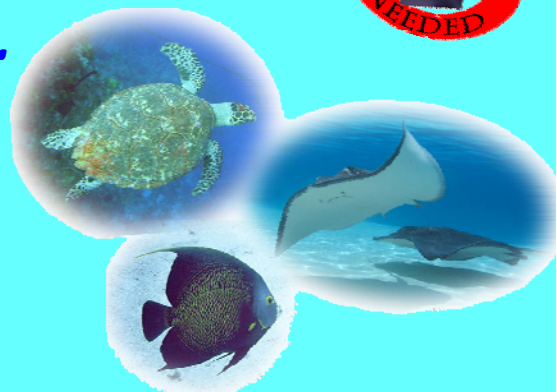

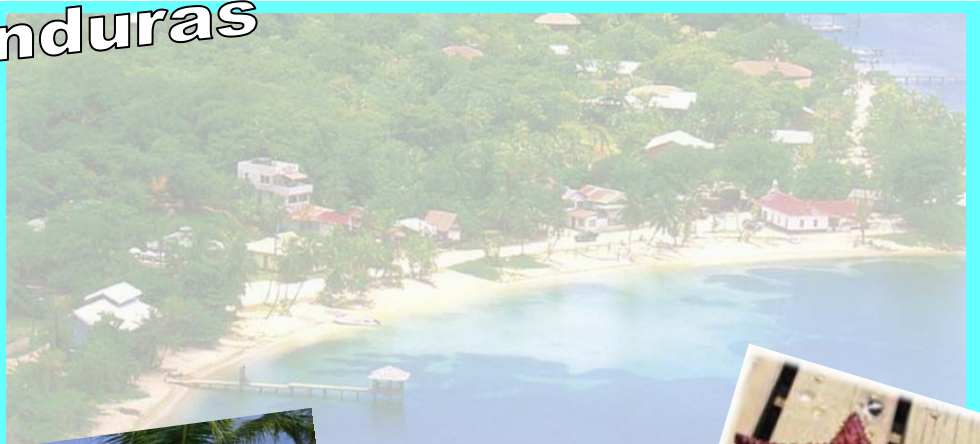
A little piece of paradise...

Noteworthy is the **Chankanaab National Park**, a Cozumel icon, and the **Punta Sur Ecological Reserve**. This huge protected area at the southern tip of the island includes Punta Celarain and its historical lighthouse, and the Colombia Lagoon, a shelter for many of the island's widespread species as well as other endangered forms of life such as marine turtles and their nesting areas.

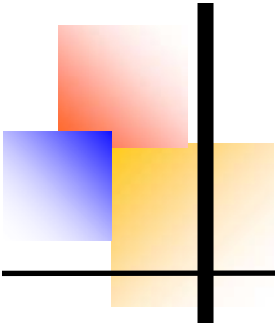
