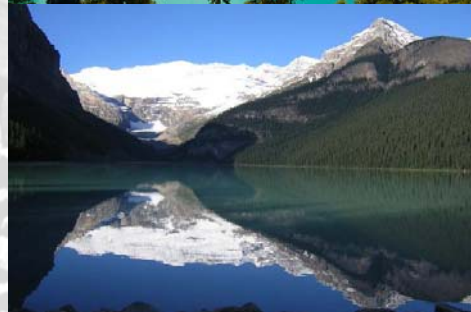
Banff National Park

Canada's oldest national park was established in 1885 in the Rocky Mountains. This glorious park encompasses 2,564 square miles of mountainous terrain with numerous glaciers and ice fields, dense coniferous forest, and alpine landscapes. The **Icefields Parkway** extends from **Lake Louise** connecting to **Jasper National Park** in the north.

Lake Louise - Marvel at the emerald waters of Lake Louise set against the stark backdrop of Victoria Glacier which is probably the most beloved and most photographed scene in the Canadian Rockies. The region abounds with spectacular scenery, from glaciers to waterfalls.

Icefields Parkway - The Icefields Parkway, also known as Highway 93, is a scenic road in Alberta, Canada. It parallels the Continental Divide, traversing the rugged landscape of the Canadian Rockies. It travels through Banff National Park and Jasper National Park, linking Lake Louise and Jasper.

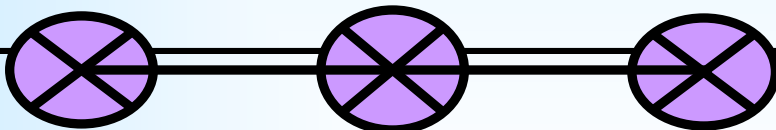
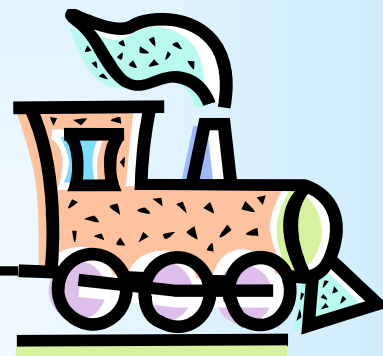


JASPER - 1 Night

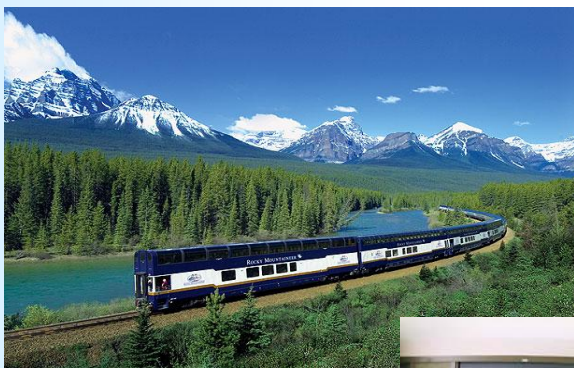

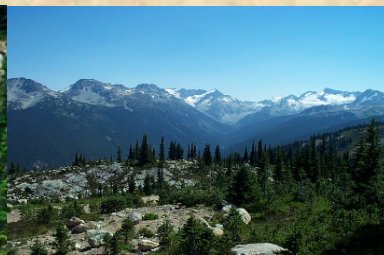
Jasper National Park

Quesnel, British Columbia (1 Night)

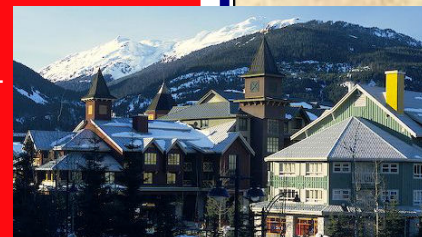

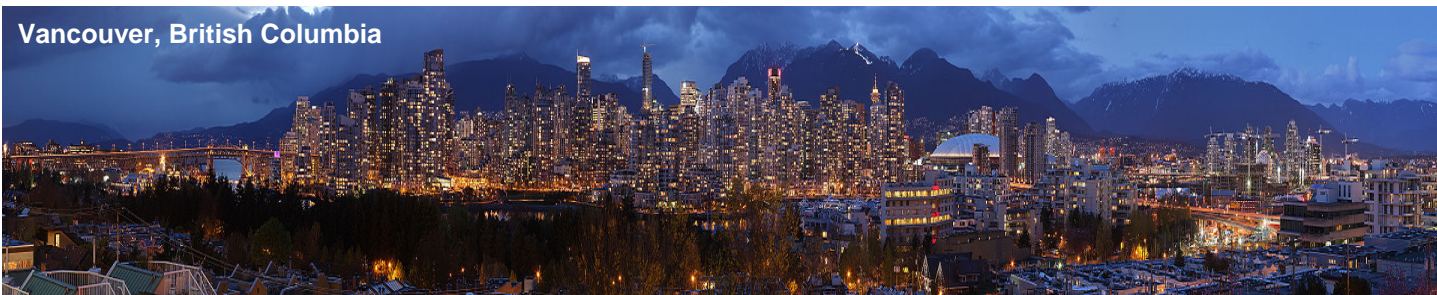
Howe Sound

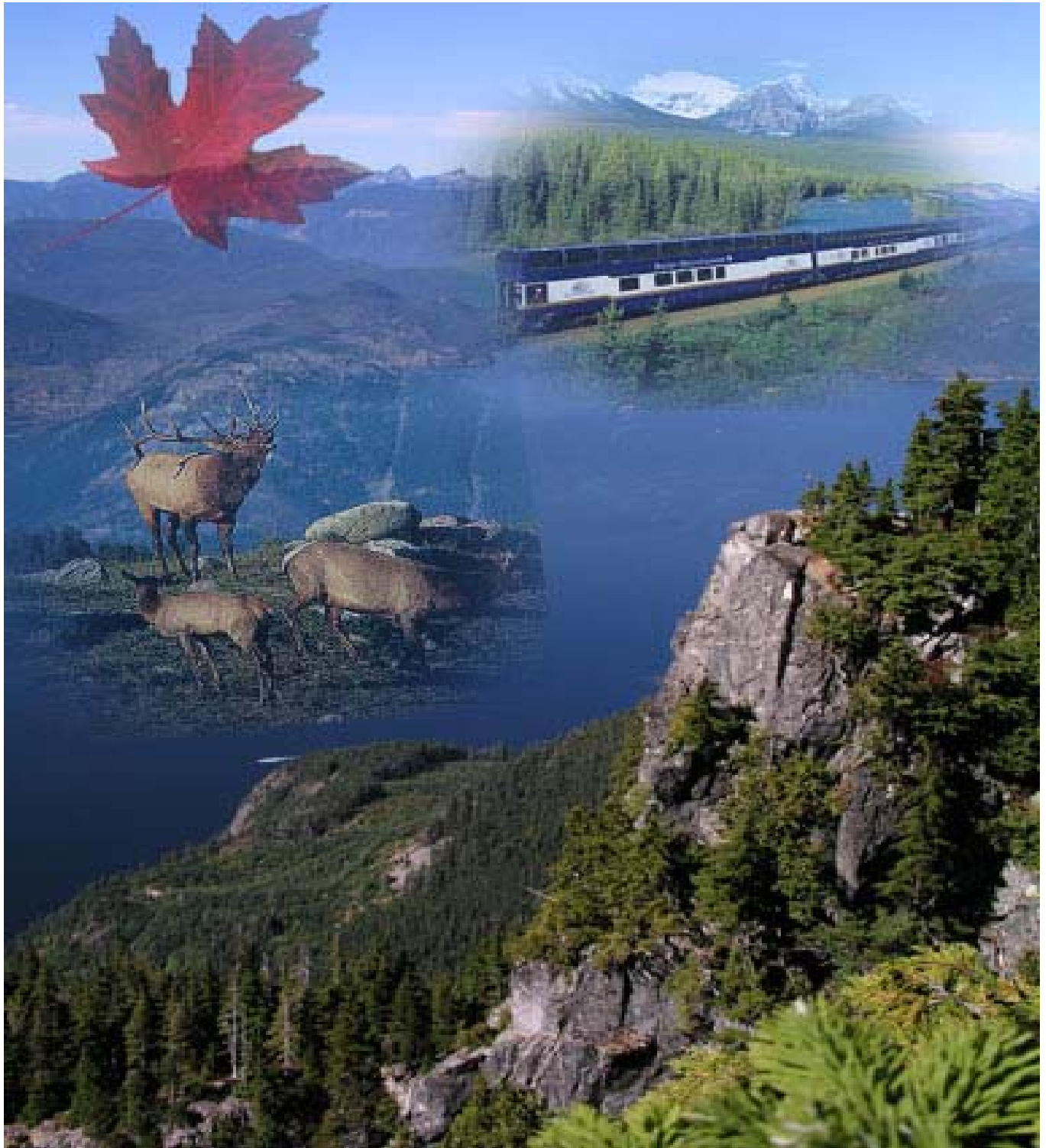

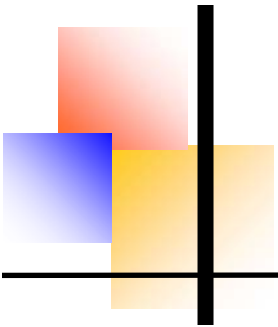

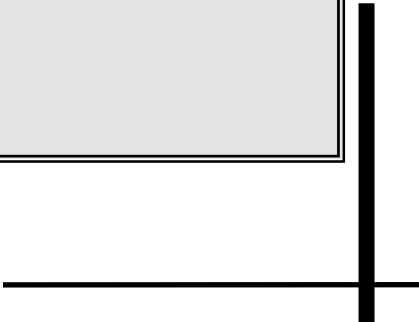
