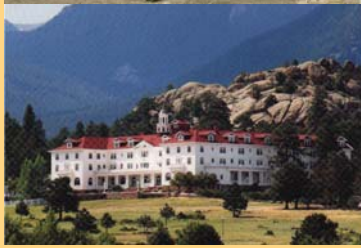
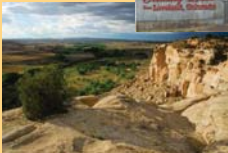

COLORADO

Yuma, Brush, Ft. Morgan, and Greeley-

As we travel through Colorado, view the amazing fields of truck farming and sugar beets.

Loveland - Arrange a Valentine card to be sent to your sweetheart from Loveland, Colorado to arrive on February 14, 2012!

Big Thompson Canyon -

Be sure and have your cameras ready as we drive through the beautiful Big Thompson Canyon. The thirty-two mile drive from the city of Loveland to the entrance of Estes Park is one of the most beautiful drives in Colorado.

Estes Park (1 Night) - There will be free time in Estes Park to shop on your own or maybe hit a few golf balls.

- **Trail Ridge Road** - The highest continuous paved highway in North America, travels through the heart of **Rocky Mountain National Park** from Estes Park to Grand Lake. Passengers can view alpine tundra which blankets a full third of the Park. At this altitude you'll find a fragile environment of animals and aged, but dwarfed, plants that have adapted to the arctic-like winter conditions.

- **Stanley Hotel (1 Night)** - Famous for its old world charm, The Stanley Hotel boasts spectacular views in every direction and is less than six miles away from Rocky Mountain National Park. Multi-million dollar renovations have restored this 138-guestroom hotel to its original grandeur. Freelan Oscar Stanley was the co-founder of the Stanley Motor Company which manufactured the Stanley Steamer car.

The Eisenhower Tunnel - Officially the Eisenhower-Johnson Memorial Tunnel, is a dual-bore, four-lane vehicular tunnel approximately 60 miles west of Denver. The tunnel carries Interstate 70 under the Continental Divide in the Rocky Mountains and is one of the highest vehicular tunnels in the world. The tunnel is the longest mountain tunnel and highest point on the Interstate Highway system.

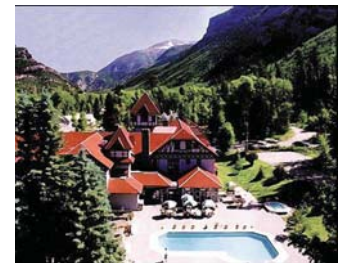
Silverthorne - A bustling ski area getaway.

- **The Historic Mint** - Dine in one of the oldest buildings in Summit County and grill your own steak on the specially seasoned lava rock grill. In business since 1862, this is the locals' choice for steaks, seafood, and fun! Meal is included.

Glenwood Springs - Glenwood Springs is known for its medicinal hot sulfur springs, rich natural history and scenic beauty. Glenwood Canyon was one of the most challenging sections of the interstate highway system. Because of environmentalists, this beautiful engineering phenomenon was constructed!

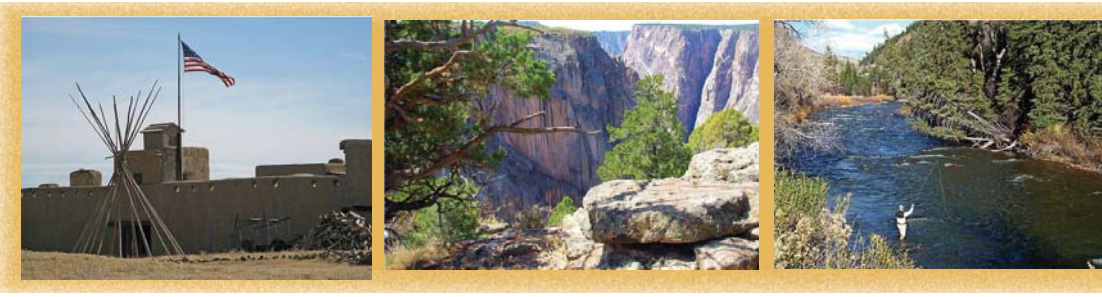
Redstone - This mountain village is hidden surprisingly beneath the massive red cliffs. The entire village is on the National Register of Historic Places.

- **Redstone Inn (1 Night)** - A beautiful rustic turn of the century style Rocky Mountain Resort Lodge in Colorado.



Black Canyon of Gunnison National Park

Your cameras will be busy during this portion of the drive. No other canyon in North America combines the narrow opening, sheer walls, and startling depth offered by the Black Canyon of Gunnison.



Montrose (1 Night) - Home to the Black Canyon National Park, scenic mountains, valleys, canyons, mesas, lakes and rivers.

Silverton - One of Colorado's most endearing destinations. Enjoy a couple of hours to shop and eat here.

Durango - Known for the Durango & Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad. It is a heritage railway which travels from Durango to the historic mining town of Silverton, Colorado on steam-powered trains with rolling stock. It dates back to at least the 1920s. We drive this beautiful route in our motor coach!

NEW MEXICO

Aztec

- **Aztec Ruins National Monument** - This monument preserves ancestral Pueblo structures in north-western New Mexico. What remains today is a walled village with almost 400 rooms on 3 levels, and over a dozen kivas (circular ceremonial areas).

Farmington (1 Night) - Nestled in the picturesque San Juan River Valley, Farmington is within sight of Colorado's rugged San Juan Mountains and the desert highlands of Arizona and Utah. Farmington is the commercial center of the Four Corners Region.

Cumbres

- **Cumbres & Toltec Scenic Railroad** - We take this historic train from **Chama, New Mexico** to **Antonito, Colorado!** The Cumbres & Toltec was originally constructed in 1880 as part of the Rio Grande's San Juan Extension, which served the silver mining district of the San Juan Mountains in southwestern Colorado.

COLORADO

Manassa -

- **Jack Dempsey Museum & Birthplace**

Alamosa (1 Night) - which means "cottonwood" in Spanish, is the hub of the San Luis Valley and many nearby attractions.

Mosca

- **Colorado Gator Farm** - See the BIGGEST gators in the West!

Canon City

- **Royal Gorge Bridge** - This is America's highest suspension bridge. Gliding more than 1,100 feet above the canyon floor is America's longest single-span Aerial Tram. The ride offers exceptional 360-degree views of the Gorge, the Bridge, the Park and Colorado's majestic Sangre de Cristo Mountains.

Pueblo - It is said that the earliest permanent building in Colorado was erected in Pueblo.

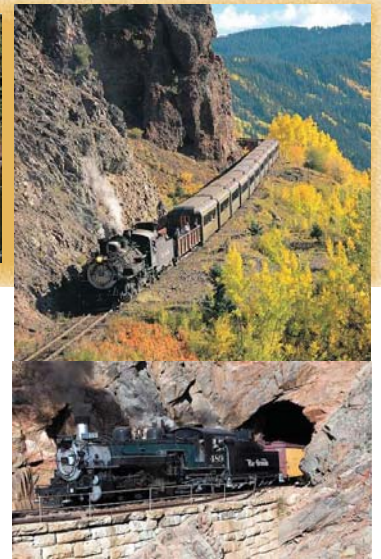
Rocky Ford - Enjoy a stop at a local favorite fruit stand. You may choose to purchase some fruit to enjoy this evening.

La Junta (1 Night)

Bent's Old Fort National Historic Site - Features a reconstructed 1840's adobe fur trading post on the mountain branch of the Santa Fe Trail where traders, trappers, travelers, and Plains Indian tribes came together for trade. Kit Carson was hired as a hunter to provide meat for the people living at the fort.
