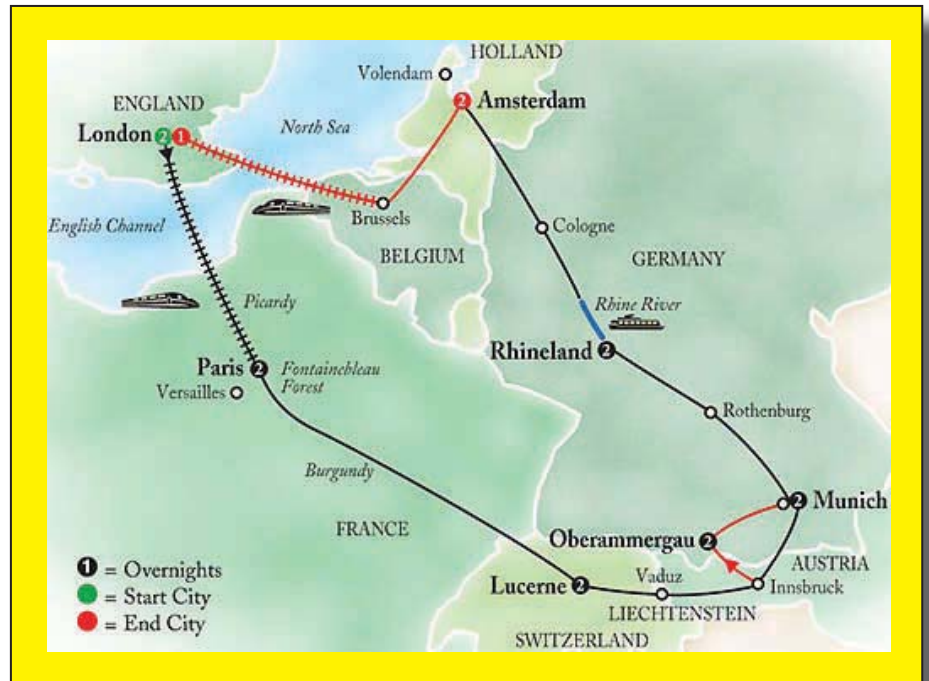

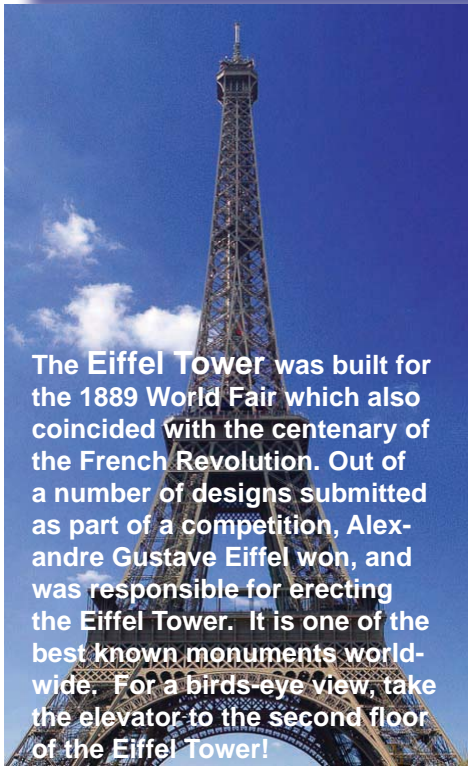
Paris, France

2 Nights



Board the **Eurostar Train** to reach your next destination of Paris. Eurostar is a high-speed railway passenger service that will connect London with Paris. All its trains cross under the English Channel via the Channel Tunnel between Britain and France.

With a local guide, explore the world of chic and style. Free time in the evening gives you the chance to take in an optional cabaret show, an illumination drive of the city, or visit the lavish Palace of Versailles.



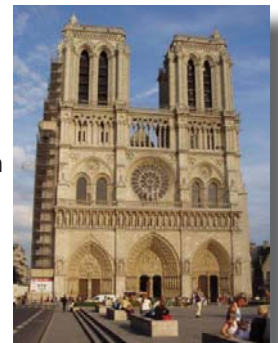
The Eiffel Tower was built for the 1889 World Fair which also coincided with the centenary of the French Revolution. Out of a number of designs submitted as part of a competition, Alexandre Gustave Eiffel won, and was responsible for erecting the Eiffel Tower. It is one of the best known monuments worldwide. For a birds-eye view, take the elevator to the second floor of the Eiffel Tower!

The **Avenue des Champs-Élysées** is a prestigious avenue in Paris, France. With its cinemas, cafés, luxury specialty shops and clipped chestnut trees, the Avenue des Champs-Élysées is one of the most famous streets in the world.



Notre Dame Cathedral -

Notre Dame de Paris is the cathedral of the Catholic archdiocese of Paris. Notre Dame de Paris is widely considered one of the finest examples of French Gothic architecture in the world. The name Notre Dame means "Our Lady" in French, and is frequently used in the names of Catholic church buildings in Francophone countries.



The **Arc de Triomphe** is a monument that stands in the centre of the Place Charles de Gaulle. It is at the western end of the Champs-Élysées. The triumphal arch honors those who fought for France, particularly during the Napoleonic Wars. On the inside and the top of the arc there are all of the names of generals and wars fought. Underneath is the tomb of the unknown soldier from World War I.



Lucerne, Switzerland

2 Nights

Take a comfortable ride down the highway skirting the **Fontainebleau Forest** and the **vineyards of Burgundy** to the Swiss border. Take in the **Alps** as you enter the spectacular city of **Lucerne**.



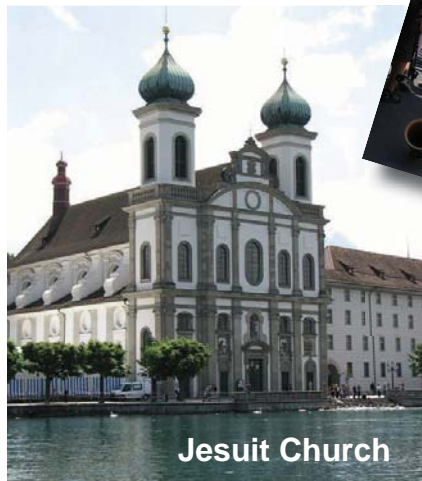
Thorvaldsen's Lion Monument (1819) commemorates the sacrifice of more than six hundred Swiss Guards who died defending the Tuileries during the French Revolution. The monument portrays a dying lion lying across broken symbols of the French monarchy. The sculpture was carved in a sandstone cliff above the city center.



Chapel Bridge - This 670 ft long bridge crossing the Reuss River in the city of Lucerne is the oldest wooden bridge in Europe, and one of Switzerland's main tourist attractions. The covered bridge, constructed in 1333, was designed to help protect the city of Lucerne from attacks. Inside the bridge are a series of paintings from the 17th century, depicting events from Lucerne's history. Much of the bridge, and the majority of these paintings, were destroyed in a 1993 fire, though it was quickly rebuilt.

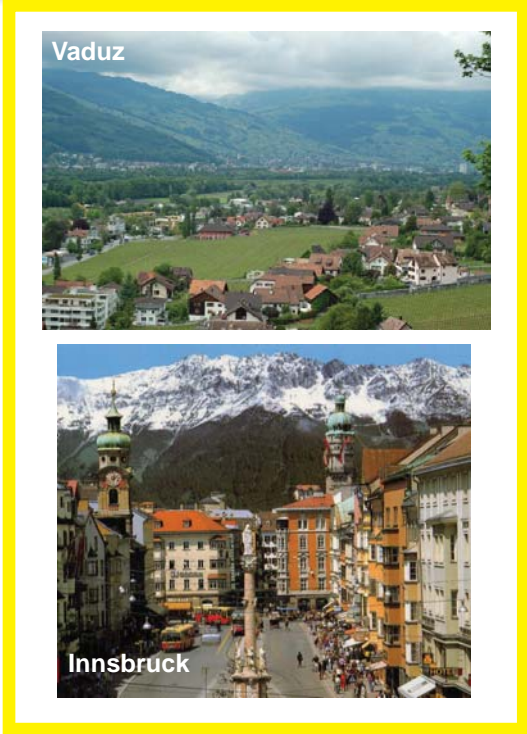
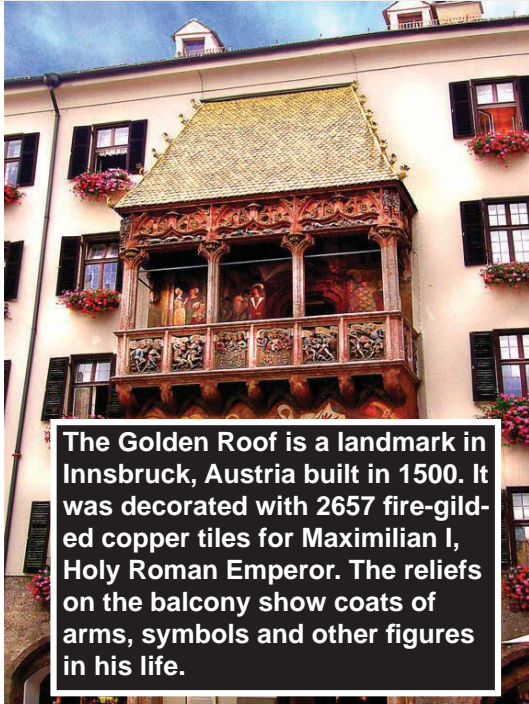

Vaduz, Liechtenstein ~ Innsbruck, Austria

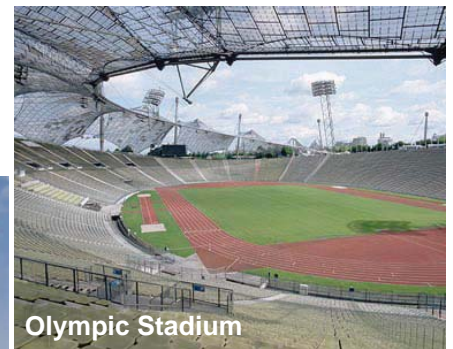
After leaving Lucerne, your travels will take you to a morning break in **Vaduz**, the capital of the Principality of Liechtenstein.

In **Innsbruck**, stroll through the quaint medieval lanes and visit **Emperor Maximilian's Golden Roof**. Then, take in the beautiful mountain views along the road from the Austrian Tyrol to Bavaria and **Munich**.



Munich, Germany 2 Nights

Sometimes called the "Village of One Million" Munich is a southern city located near the Alps. This wonderfully charming 800-year-old city is the capital of Bavaria and the home of the world-famous Oktoberfest. Sightseeing with a local guide will take you to many sites of interest while in Munich.

Rothenburg

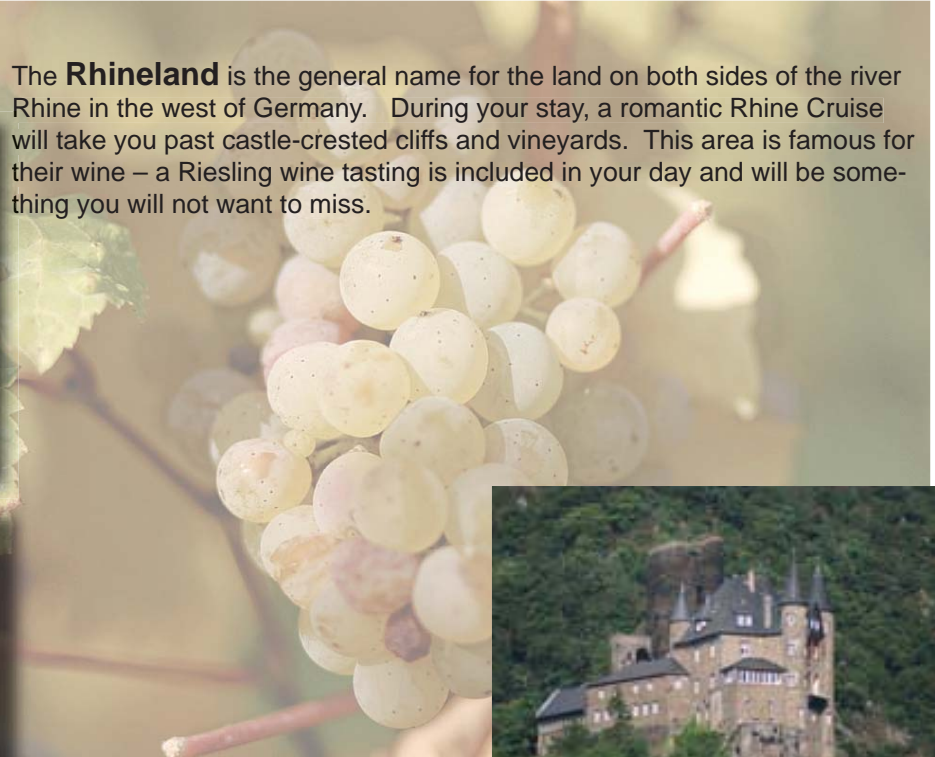

Rhineland 2 Nights



The **Rhineland** is the general name for the land on both sides of the river Rhine in the west of Germany. During your stay, a romantic Rhine Cruise will take you past castle-crested cliffs and vineyards. This area is famous for their wine – a Riesling wine tasting is included in your day and will be something you will not want to miss.



Cologne

Cologne is the location where the cathedral spires tower over Germany's oldest city and its innumerable cultural and historical treasures, world-famous museums and active art scene can be found. A visit to the Cathedral is included on this stopover.



Amsterdam, Holland

2 Nights

Continue through the Dutch region to **Amsterdam**. Amsterdam is one of the greatest small cities in the world. From its canals to world-famous museums and historical sights, Amsterdam is one of the most romantic and beautiful cities in Europe. Studded with canals and bridges, Amsterdam begs to be explored, which is exactly what you will do. With a local guide, enjoy a canal cruise to see the patrician mansions, gabled facades, humpback bridges, and hear about this 700-year-old capital's history. Then, visit a major diamond center.

"One of the most beautiful town squares in Europe, if not in the world", is a phrase often heard when visitors in Brussels try to describe the beauty of the central market square. 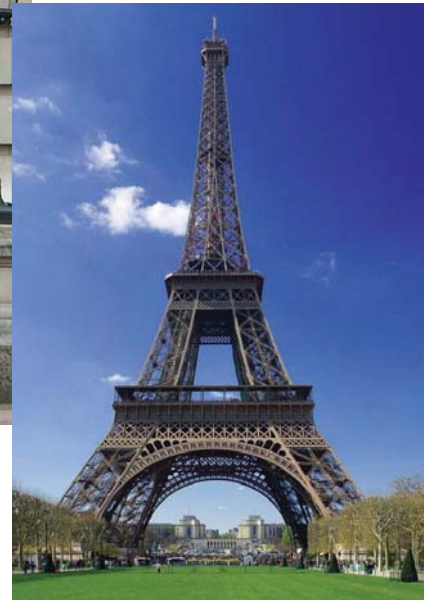
