One of the few engineering marvels in the world, with its own palindrome, the **Panama Canal** is a must-see!

The Panama Canal is a ship canal that extends across the Isthmus of Panama, joining the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans. The Canal is 50 miles long from deep water in the Caribbean to deep water in the Pacific. Although there are 12 sets of locks total, there are only six massive pairs of locks that ships use for transit, each 1,000 feet long and 110 feet wide. Each may be filled or emptied in less than 10 minutes, and each pair of lock gates takes two minutes to open.

A Few Optional Tours While There... Travel to one of Panama's most magnificent rainforest preserves and explore remote jungle trails on a guided nature walk. Cruise to a group of islands where monkeys and other native animals can be viewed in their natural habitat. Go bass fishing in Gatun Lake. Visit an Embera Indian village.

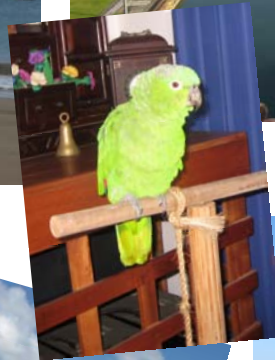
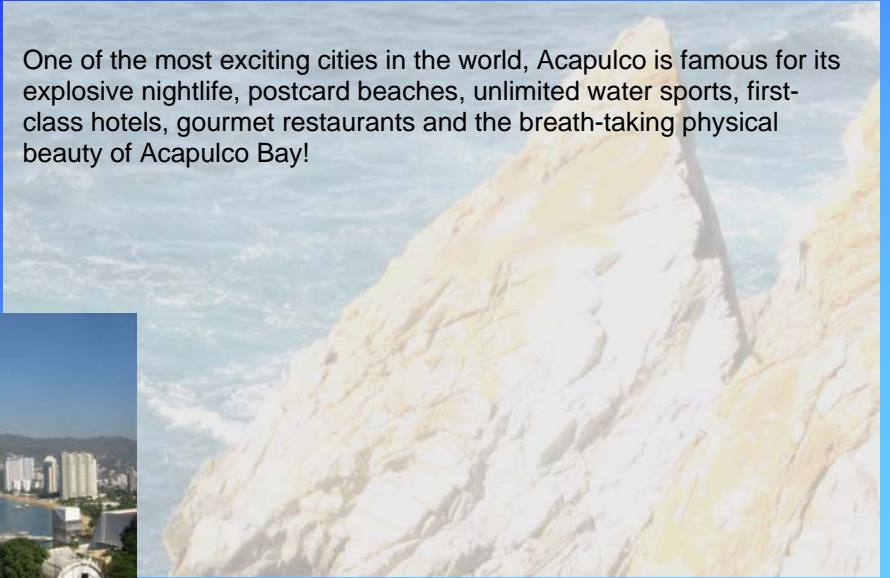

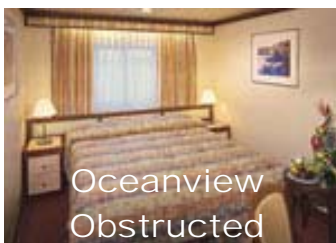
