*A six-day land tour of RIO DE JANEIRO, BRAZIL, IGUAZU FALLS, and BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA, will be followed by 16 days on the luxurious Star Princess cruise ship and then two post nights in SANTIAGO, CHILE.*



### 6 DAY LAND TOUR

**Rio De Janeiro (3 Nights)** - Rio De Janeiro is the second largest city in Brazil and is famous for its spectacular natural setting, its Carnival celebrations, samba. Ride a cable car to the top of **Sugarloaf Mountain**, the symbol of Rio de Janeiro, and drink in the panoramic view of the city and its white-sand beaches. You will also experience the towering **Christ the Redeemer Statue** - recently voted one of the new 7 Wonders of the World. The statue perches high atop Corcovado Mountain, Rio's highest peak. Board a train and ride to the top of the mountain, then continue up escalators to the main viewing platform. Headed by French sculptor Paul Landowsky, a team of artisans labored on the 125-foot tall concrete and soapstone figure. Completed in 1931, the statue is, along with Sugarloaf Mountain, one of Rio's internationally recognized symbols.



Iguazu. An amazing walking tour of the Brazilian side of the falls will begin your adventure. Lying on the border of two countries and stretching for more than two miles, you'll first take a walking tour of the Brazilian side of spectacular Iguazu Falls. Your tour of the Argentine side of the falls includes a ride aboard the **Ecological Jungle Train** to see the unforgettable **Devil's Throat**. For a different perspective, optional excursions are available (additional cost).

**Buenos Aires (1 Night)** Fly into Buenos Aires and enjoy an evening of a **spectacular tango show and Argentine beef dinner**. The next morning explore the city sights of the "Paris of the South" including a stop at **Recoleta Cemetery**. This remarkable cemetery in the city's exclusive Barrio Norte is the scene of ornately decorated marble crypts - including the black marble crypt of the legendary Eva Peron.



**Iguazu Falls (2 Nights)** - The most spectacular waterfalls in South America! Located on the Iguazu River, the falls divide the river into the upper and lower

**Montevideo, Uruguay-** Montevideo, Uruguay's capital city, is located at Uruguay's southernmost point on the Rio de la Plata. A charming city made up of 19th century Beau Arts buildings, parks, and historic monuments, Montevideo is home to more than half of the nation's three million citizens. Small in size, but large in status.

**Optional Shore Excursions:** Soccer Museum / Legislative Palace / Prado Park / Plaza Independencia / Estancia La Rabida / Santa Rosa Winery / Graff Spee Monument / Holocaust Memorial, and more.

**Falkland Islands (Stanley)** - Stanley, capital of the Falklands, is a tiny British outpost where the absence of traffic lights and abundance of pubs in comparison to its size makes this a unique place. Situated near Cape Horn in South America, the harbor at Stanley is one of the world's largest shipping graveyards of the 19th century. The Falklands is also a bird-watchers haven, with an amazing diversity of seabirds and mammals that breed in the Falklands.

**Optional Shore Excursions:** Britannia House Museum / Christchurch Cathedral / 1982 Liberation Monument / 1914 Battle Memorial / Falkland Battlefields / Kidney Island Cruise / Falklands Birding Expedition / Bluff Cove Penguin Rookery, and more.

**Antarctica Peninsula (Scenic Cruising - 4 Days)** - The most isolated continent on Earth, Antarctica is home to massive icebergs, majestic mountain ranges and diverse wildlife in a wilderness setting that has a purity as inspiring as it is remote. It's an amazing and precious sight. See great colonies of penguins, seals and abundant sea birds as you float nearby a dazzling icescape of remote Channel Islands.

**Cape Horn (Scenic Cruising)** - Cape Horn is the southernmost tip of South America. It's a breathtaking journey to round the Horn.



**Ushuaia (Tierra del Fuego), Argentina -**

Ushuaia is the southernmost city in the world and one of two main cities on the island territory of Tierra del Fuego. Shared by Argentina and Chile, "The Land of Fire" features unforgettable scenery and trails of discovery framed by the sea, forests, lakes and mountains.

**Optional Shore Excursions:** Beagle Channel Wildlife Cruise / Tierra Mayor Natural Reserve Trek /Tierra del Fuego National Park / Canoe Adventure in the National Park, and more.

**Punta Arenas, Chile** - Punta Arenas lies atop rolling hills, looking out over the Strait of Magellan. The city is also the gateway to Chilean Patagonia, a maze of fjords, rivers, steppes and mountains to the north. Adventure awaits at this port near the end of the earth.

**Santiago (Valparaiso), Chile (Post Package—2 days/nights)** - *Your package includes a half-day city tour and a full day visit to a renowned Chilean winery that includes wine tasting and lunch. Then, spend the rest of your time enjoying the city on your own.* Santiago sprawls at the feet of the snow-capped Andes.
